Picture in your mind your sponsor and then think of the sacrifice your sponsor made to not just invite you to take part in the weekend but the numerous other things they did for you. For you because they wanted to make sure you felt loved. They were following the Commandment that Christ gave to us – Love each other. Won’t you make the same sacrifice for someone else?
