2 Corinthians 11:6-11 (Today's NIV 2005)

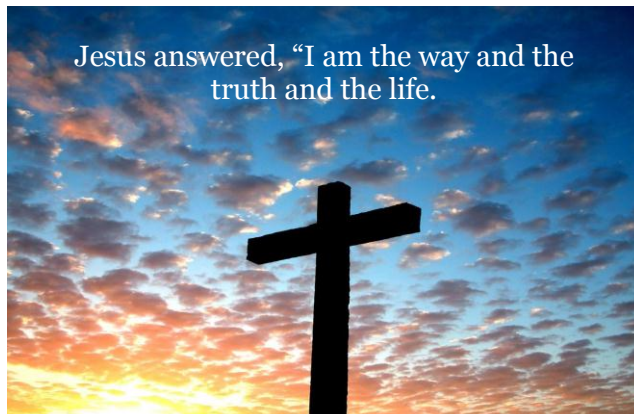

We have made this perfectly clear to you in every way. ⁷ Was it a sin for me to lower myself in order to elevate you by preaching the gospel of God to you free of charge? ⁸ I robbed other churches by receiving support from them so as to serve you. ⁹ And when I was with you and needed something, I was not a burden to anyone, for the brothers and sisters who came from Macedonia supplied what I needed. I have kept myself from being a burden to you in any way, and will continue to do so. ¹⁰ As surely as the truth of Christ is in me, nobody in the regions of Achaia will stop this boasting of mine. ¹¹ Why? Because I do not love you? God knows I do!

Hopefully, you have read this and think about who needs your help, who would need the weekend to understand more of what the Lord has for them. When we sit and pray, has Christ lifted someone to you that weighs on your heart? I know that with all that we have to dedicate our lives to, we leave some things to the last minute. When we start to see the deadline that is when we hurriedly work to get those priorities to the front. As I have tried to impress on my kids – do things when you see that they need to be done. Let us not procrastinate on getting our pilgrims registered or making the Agape for the Flights and Walks. Let us pray every day for all of those involved in Our Community and Our Churches. As we are disciples let us build others to be disciples.

Just as Paul loved all he spoke to and taught, we should be the same with our brothers and sisters in Christ. Let us all take that step of sponsoring those that Christ has brought to us and continue the sponsorship after the walk by being a strong brother and sister to them.
