Practical Preparation (Part one)

You've gotten the prospective Pilgrim to agree to go on an Emmaus Walk; explained the general framework of the weekend; answered questions to alleviate fears and filled out the paperwork. The next step is..... the money discussion. It takes money to pay for all the needed materials, space and food to hold a Walk. The Lexington Emmaus Community requires a deposit of \$50.00 to "hold" the space on the weekend, with the total equalling \$150.00.

MONEY QUESTION



Many Pilgrims will not have a problem paying the deposit or the entire cost of the weekend; but we are in tough economic times and money may be an issue. As a sponsor you are not required to pay for your Pilgrim's fee; having said that you may have the financial means to help with the cost, either partially or in total. There are other ways to obtain financial help for Pilgrims if needed. Many of our churches with Emmaus members in their congregations have scholarship funds; even if they don't there may be some help through leadership funds that the church has set aside in the annual budget. Talk to the Pilgrim's pastor to see what help the church may be able to provide. After all, the Emmaus experience is designed to grow leadership for our churches!

The Lexington Emmaus Community has its own scholarship fund, set up through memorial funds. We have used the interest generated to fund 3 half scholarships per Walk or Flight. The application for the scholarship is online and should be submitted along with the application. In addition, we have a scholarship committee that is working on creating an additional fund with other gifts.

"Wisdom is a shelter as money is a shelter, but the advantage of knowledge is this: that wisdom preserves the life of its possessor" (Ecclesiastes 7:12). It is very challenging to sustain these funds so that we can assist as many people as possible for as long as we can, please keep the finances of the Community and those who oversee them in your prayers.

If none of these avenues leads to funding don't give up, contact the Community Registrar and they will work with you. While you may be the sponsor, we as the Community have a responsibility to each and every person who attends the Emmaus Walk. We have many resources to assist you, not just with the financial aspect of helping your Pilgrim, but also through prayer, mentorship and service.

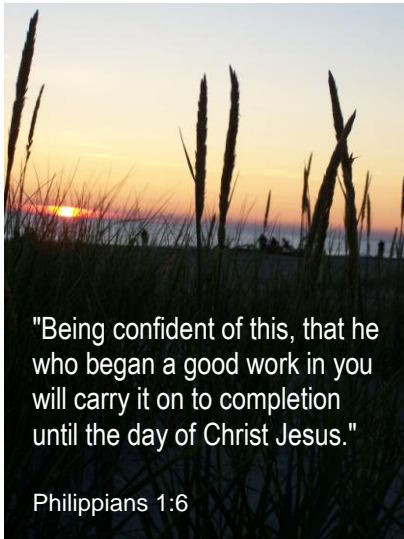
