## HEART OF KENYA, WALK WITH CHRIST

"Walk with Christ" is a three-day weekend retreat similar to the Emmaus Walk.

A team is being sent to Kenya to hold the first three Walk with Christ weekends there on May 31 to June 2, June 3-6, and June 11-14. The group leading the weekends (in association with Kenya Medical Outreach) asks for support. If you are so led, here are some things they need:

1. Pray for the groups/teams as they prepare, travel, and lead the weekends.
2. Send personal agape letters they so desperately need. They are asking for a packet of 55 letters for each weekend with each letter being put into a separate envelope. These should be sent to Walnut Grove UMC, 915 Church Way, Loganville, GA 30052, Attention: Mick Derrick (Kenya Walk with Christ).
3. They are trying to give each attendee a Bible. They believe the cost of Bibles in the local language will be \$5.50 each. If you would like to make a donation for the purpose of purchasing Bibles, please make out checks to Walnut Grove UMC and put **KMO Bibles** on the memo line.
