Here is some information about Carl Hurley.

Dr. Carl Hurley grew up in the Appalachian Mountains of Eastern Kentucky and now resides in Lexington. He holds a Bachelor of Science and a Master's Degree in Industrial Education from the Eastern Kentucky University and a Doctorate in Education from the University of Missouri.

Carl spent several years as an educator in his native state. For eight years, he was a professor of education at Eastern Kentucky University and coordinated the university's secondary education program.

Several years ago, faced with an increasing number of invitations to speak, Carl left his professorship to become a full-time speaker and entertainer.

Featured on what was formerly the Nashville Network, he has also made numerous appearances on the Bill Gaither Homecoming Series and Public Television. Carl holds the professional designation of Certified Speaking Professional and was inducted by his peers in to the National Speakers Association CPAE Speakers Hall of Fame. Carl's humor is heard regularly on the XM Satellite Network on Channel 150.

Perhaps he is most proud of being inducted into ECU's Alumni Hall of Fame and receiving the institution's honorary doctorate.

Carl believes that humor is the best carrier for his message. He has certainly earned the title of "America's Funniest Professor."
