Directions to Asbury Theological Seminary

From Lexington take Harrodsburg Rd., US 68 south. US 68 and KY 29 merge at the flashing light and then KY 29 bears left at the convenience store and goes into Wilmore where it becomes Lexington Ave. Registration/Send-Off is in Beeson Manor. Coming from Lexington, go past the first stoplight in Wilmore (East College St.) then turn left on Gillispie St. Beeson Manor is the last building off the circular drive where you can drop people off. Parking is in the lot across the street from Beeson Manor. Candlelight and Closings are in Estes Chapel. Estes Chapel is on Lexington Ave. on the left beyond the library. It is distinguishable by its steeple.
