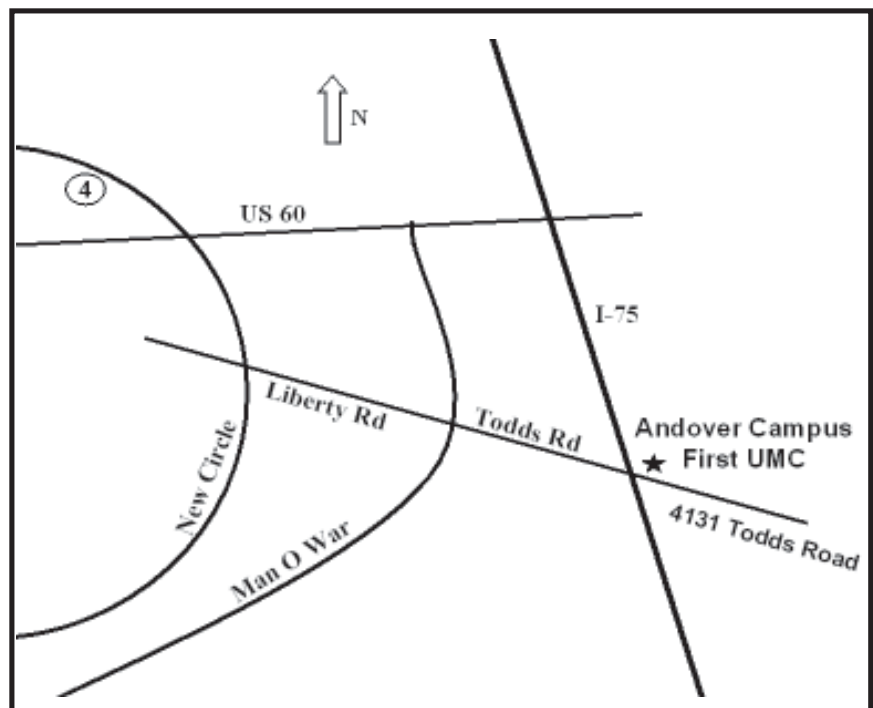
On behalf of the Lexington Emmaus Board, I want to thank St. Luke Church United Methodist Church their many years of gracious hospitality.

Board Of Director's Election

The Community has been blessed by the willingness of the following individuals who have agreed to serve if elected to the Lexington Emmaus Community's Board of Directors.

The area of ministry assigned to each Board member will be determined by the Board following the election. Each person on the Board is elected for a three (3) year term and may serve only one (1) term. The Emmaus Board sincerely believes that these nominees are qualified and enthusiastic about serving the Lexington Community. Your vote is important and we ask you to prayerfully consider each candidate as you vote for up to three (3) lay and one (1) clergy candidates. A brief "Emmaus Biography" of each nominee follows:

Elsie Banks: Lexington Women's Walk #18. Attends Highland Christian Church (DOC) of Frankfort. She has served on numerous Walk and Chrysalis teams and has served in all lay team areas. She was Lay Director of Walk #44. She would like to see the Board focus on ways of maintaining Pilgrim's participation in Emmaus during their Fourth Days as well as finding ways of getting more male Pilgrims and Caterpillars to go on Walks and Flights.

Pam Chandler: Lexington's Women's Walk #20. Attends Trinity Hill United Methodist Church in Lexington. She has served on various Emmaus Walks (Music, Agape, Agape Chair, Asst. Table Leader, Table Leader, Assistant Lay Director, Lay Director in Training on Walk #82) and on two Chrysalis Flights (Music Leader).

Janelle Lane: Lexington Women's Walk #64. Attends Centenary United Methodist in Danville. She has worked on a number of Walks and is currently preparing to serve as a Table Leader on this fall's Women's Walk #82.

Brad Porter: Greater Cincinnati Men's Walk #27. Attends Wilmore Free Methodist Church. He has served on three Boy's Chrysalis Flights and an REC at the Federal Medical Center. He graduated from Asbury Theological Seminary and has often served on Walks by serving meals and actively participating in Candlelights and Closings. Has sponsored three pilgrims.

Jesse Yoder: Lexington Men's Walk #71. Attends the First Assembly of God where he is involved in the Music Ministry. He holds a degree in Music from Ashland University. He lives in Wilmore and has served on teams in Agape, as Prayer Chapel Coordinator and as an Assistant Table Leader.

Jerri Williams: Lexington Women's Walk #48. Pastor of Brick by Brick United Methodist Church in Lexington. She has served on five Walks (65, 68, 72, 74 & 80) and four Chrysalis Flights (16, 18, 22 & 23) and has given the *Sanctifying Grace*, *God Empowers You* and *God Loves You* talks.
