What is Servant Leadership?

The Emmaus movement does not exist primarily for the weekend Walks. Its purposes are to deepen the faith of individuals, to increase the faith of congregations, and to bring Christianity to the world. Emmaus gives pilgrims the skills needed for leadership and invites them to make the commitment needed to build up the church for the sake of Jesus Christ. The questions asked at the closing - "What has this weekend meant to you?" and "What are you going to do with it?" -- help pilgrims begin to comprehend the kind of servant leadership that God may require of them in the future. Recently members of the Lexington Emmaus Board went to Corbin to attend the Southeast Regional Training; we had eight training sessions, one of which was about servant leadership. I'd like to share some of my notes from that session.

True leadership begins with a servant's heart (Philippians 2:5-8).

Servant leaders follow Jesus rather than seek position and glory (Mark 10:35-40).

Servant leaders give up their own rights to serve others (Mark 10:41-45).

Servant leaders take up the towel of Jesus to meet the needs of others (John 13:3-5, 12-17).

Servant leaders share responsibilities and empower others to lead (Matthew 28:19-20 and Exodus 18:17-21).

Servant leaders know where they are leading (Deuteronomy 17:18-20a).

Servant leaders spend time in scripture and prayer (John 15:1-5 and Nehemiah 1:4).

Servant leaders **Equip** others (Thessalonians 5:11)

Qualify for service (2Timothy 2:2)

Understand needs (Luke 11:1)

Instruct (1Timothy 4:11-12).

Pray for others (John 17: 6-10 & 15-20).

Togetherness (Mark 6:7).

Empowerment (Acts 1:8).

Accountability (Hebrews 13:17).

Mentoring (Matthew 5:1-2 and Luke 6:12-13).

As I walk on through my 4th Days...

I took my Emmaus Walk in 1989. Since then, my fourth days have been filled with the things life brings: children leaving home for college, marriages, new jobs and relocating, unemployment of my husband, death of my last living parent, health issues for loved ones and for me, and my husband's retirement. Many of these difficult times were surrounded by participation on an Emmaus team. Somehow, God knew when I once again needed to be encouraged by the messages one hears on a walk. I am privileged to serve on the women's team for the fall.

At this point in my fourth days, I am struggling with the decision of when to retire. I enjoy my work but would like to slow down and have more freedom. It is my duly appointed time to contact Social Security to sign up for Medicare and tell them my plan for retirement. Getting information from Social Security is like wringing out a dry cloth! I have talked to 2 different men in Baltimore after wading through the recorded choices on their phone system. The first man appeared to know what he was talking about, but I wasn't smart enough to know all the questions on the first call. The second man put me on hold for 15 minutes then negated everything the first man said and referred me to the Social Security website. Don't even go there! The government lingo is meant to confuse and muddle your brain. My question of when to retire has been offered up to a much higher authority! I have also added the Social Security Administration to my prayer list!

The bottom line is I thank God that He can be trusted to meet my needs throughout my fourth days, in **all** circumstances! I keep a folder of stories, sermon notes, song lyrics, etc. that touch me. I share with you the refrain of a song called *Trust His Heart* by Eddie Carswell and Babbie Mason. You can hear the whole song on You Tube. I hope this will encourage you in your fourth days as it has me.
